

Stephen Randall “Randy” Finfrock

1947 – 2025



Stephen Randall Finfrock, known to family and friends as Randy, passed away on March 23, 2025, at the age of 77 after a courageous 23-year battle with prostate cancer.

Randy was born in Beloit, Kansas, in 1947 and moved to Lawrence, Kansas, at the age of twelve. He attended Central Junior High and graduated from Lawrence High School, later earning his degree from the University of Kansas in 1965. Randy had an adventurous spirit that drew him to San Francisco and Berkeley, California for a brief time, before settling in Tucson, Arizona, where he lived most of his life.

In Tucson, Randy first started an education program for Indigenous youth—one of his most meaningful contributions. As his passion for his real estate began to build, he earned both his Realtor and Broker licenses. Randy worked for Grubb & Ellis Co., co-founded Commercial Retail Investors, LLC, and founded Southwest Retail Partners, LLC, building a successful career. Randy later founded Trident Mining and Minerals (MCC), formerly known as Resource Recovery Technology.

Randy is survived by his former wife, Jackie Lu Finfrock of Scottsdale, Arizona, and his three siblings: Karen Annette Aiken of Los Gatos, California; Andrew Merle Finfrock of Kenwood, California; and Craig Finfrock of Tucson, Arizona. He will be remembered for his thoughtful, inquisitive mind, and his lifelong dedication to learning as well as his gregarious personality.

A memorial service will be held in the 4th Quarter of 2025. Randy will be laid to rest in Amherst, Kansas in a generational family cemetery plot alongside his mother, sister and grandparents.
